He then transported the timber co-product to the area's farms where sawdust was - and still is in great demand as livestock and pet bedding.

This original approach with its positive environmental drive has characterised the work of Allan and his team in the intervening years and has remained an important part of the business ever since. Demand outstripped the locally available sawdust needed to supply A.W. Jenkinson Forest Product's growing customer base, which led to partnerships being formed further afield.

Today the A.W. Jenkinson Group includes a growing number of innovative businesses serving the needs of customers across the UK and northern Europe. They are all very different yet cohesive, and range from its haulage and logistics arm, A.W. Jenkinson Transport Ltd, to waste wood suppliers A&A Recycling Ltd or even bovine genetics and breeding specialists A.W. Jenkinson Farms.

Jenkinson Forest Products permanent sites right across the country, from Kinnoir in the north of Scotland to Tetbury in the south of England.

As the UK becomes more reliant on renewable energy for power generation, the drive to reduce the amount of wood disposed of to landfill has increased dramatically.

The A.W. Jenkinson Group as a whole plays a key role in the processing and transporting of all grades of recycled wood around the UK, both for biomass power generation and manufacturing.

The businesses collect and treat both processed and unprocessed recyclable wood products, from a variety of sources, including skip yards, material recycling facilities, civic amenity sites and sawmills. The products are then delivered nationwide by A.W. Jenkinson Transport to power stations, panel board mills and other manufacturers.

As well as the collection and delivery of recyclable wood, the business is also



a major logistics provider for several leading recycling and reclamation businesses. A.W. Jenkinson Transport regularly transports used tins, paper, plastics and scrap metal to mixed recycling facilities assisting with the drive to reduce the amount of waste going to landfill.

We strive to create a more efficient and sustainable approach to logistics, helping our customers – large or small – grow their business with our bespoke, cost-effective delivery and distribution solutions.


